### Frequently Asked Questions- Farm to School

#### What schools or early childhood programs are eligible?

*Programs that reside in school districts with 50% or more free and reduced lunch eligibility are potential program participants.*

#### How do I connect with schools?

*The technical assistance team will help find an eligible school or early childhood program in your area. Interested farmers should call or email Erin Caudell at 810-252-2644 or [caudelle@msu.edu](mailto:caudelle@msu.edu).*

#### I have a small farm. Do I grow enough to sell to schools?

*Hoophouses for Health staff will work with you to find an appropriately sized early childhood program for you. There are many small or home-based daycares that you could partner with.*

#### How much of my loan can I payback through Farm to School?

*You can payback up to 50% of your loan through Farm to School sales.*

#### What do you consider or what do you include in Farm to School?

*Includes early childhood programs*

#### What products can I sell via Farm to School?

*Farmers can invoice for any food product (including fruit, vegetables, culinary herbs, popcorn, and dry beans) grown on their farm. Products do not have to come from the hoophouse purchased with the loan.*
