P-EBT Michigan

Information for Farmers Market and Farm Stand Shoppers

What is P-EBT?

P-EBT is part of the federal response to food access needs during the COVID-19 pandemic that is intended to help feed kids who typically receive free or reduced lunches at school.

Can I use P-EBT at the farmers market?

You can use your P-EBT card at any farmers market or farm stand that accepts SNAP Bridge Cards.

What can I buy with my P-EBT card?

You can purchase any **SNAP** eligible food items.

How do I use my P-EBT card at the farmers market?

The farmers market will have a "market office" or tent for you to ask questions at. Most markets use a script or token system for you to make purchases with the market vendors.

Can I use P-EBT for Double Up Food Bucks?

Yes, if you use your P-EBT card at a <u>participating Double Up Food Buck site</u> it is eligible for matching incentives.

My P-EBT card has my child's name on it. Do they have to be the one to use the card?

Anyone in your household is able to use the card. The state automatically put the name of your oldest child still in school on the card.

I already have a SNAP Bridge Card. Will I get a separate card for P-EBT?

No. P-EBT funds will be added to your existing SNAP Bridge card.
